**Holy Family acolyte Philip Jax** (son of Claudia Quinn and grandson of Jamie and Gene Quinn) had disappointing 2016-2017 wrestling season when he became ill with the flu and mono and was unable to compete in the State Wrestling Tournament. He sure made up for it this year.

Philip wrestled the 2017-2018 year at both 70 lb. and 73 lb. weight classes. He has been going to practice in Dawsonville 3 and 4 days per week, and competing in tournaments all around GA every Saturday. During this 2017-2018 year there is a “ Battle For the Belt” Series. Each tournament awarded points for the top 4 places in each weight class. 1<sup>st</sup> place receives 4 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 3 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> place 2 pts and 4<sup>th</sup> place 1 pt. Philip took 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the 73 lb. and brought home the Belt for 1<sup>st</sup> place in 70 lb. These Belts were awarded to the wrestlers at the State Tournament.

Philip was so determined to win Gold this year that he decided the 6 weeks prior to the State Tournament he wanted to eat healthier and wrestle at a lower class of 67 lb. Philip gave up all Little Debbie Snacks, nightly Blue Bell Ice Cream, all bread and started drinking and eating more protein. The morning of State Philip weighed in at 66.5 lb. losing a total of 3.6 lbs. which for Philip (who doesn’ t have a single ounce of fat) was amazing.



## **PHILIP JAX A CHAMPION ON AND OFF THE MAT!**



Philip was one of 16 wrestlers in his weight class at state. Philip pinned his first opponent in 24 seconds, pinned his second opponent in 43 seconds, and the third opponent Philip bested 2-0. He never let a single wrestler score on him all the way to the Finals match. Philip’ s opponent in the Finals match had just received the status and award (that morning) of All American Triple Crown. At the end of the first period the score was tied 2-2. 2<sup>nd</sup> period both wrestlers held one another from scoring. Philip scored the final 2 pts with less than 2 seconds remaining in the last period. **Philip won GOLD.**

It has been only 2 days since the State Tournament and Philip has already received 2 offers for spots on National Teams.

Philip has also applied to Compete for TEAM GEORGIA USA in the Nationals in Iowa April 14-16, 2018.
